Hides out near bushes	Divine
Moves slowly	Xenarthran
Cannot enter direct sunlight	Ectoplasmic, Tubular
Radioactivity levels under 6	Metallic, Tubular
Radioactivity levels above 8	Ectoplasmic, Mythological
