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Here at T.A.R.D.I.S., our security systems are managed round-theclock by a vast network of computers (gray) and servers (black). But this morning the thieves launched a set of attacks that somehow compromised the network!

HACKED!

Here's what we know: 22 computers were attacked, with one code red and one code yellow attack in each row and column. No two attacks were adjacent to each other (including diagonals). The magnitudes of the attacks are listed below. Each server has an activity threshold (displayed in white), beyond which it activates an alarm. Since no alarm was triggered this morning, we know that the sum of attack magnitudes adjacent to each server (including diagonals) never exceeded the threshold for that server.

So far, we've only been able to identify five compromised computers. Can you help us locate the rest?
