



BOOTLEG PRIMATE

Note that all of the words used are nouns.


Machine A removes some number of letters from the middle of a word, leaving either end intact. Machine B adds an S to a word. Machine C moves the first letter of a word to the end. Machine D increments a letter: that is, sends it to the next letter of the alphabet. When combining words, all letters from both of the input words remain in the same order in the result, and any letters that appear in both words only appear once in the result.
