	<p>Hiring a new bartender. Make sure you can prepare a martini! I don't like it shaken so learn to S T U R G E O [N] (stir gin).</p>	<p>Looking to adopt a puppy. I find it especially cute hen puppies clean their little feet so its a plus if your puppy likes to P O L L O [C] K (paw lick).</p>	<p>We need a ouncer for our bar as well. You might need to M [U] S S E L some drunk patrons.</p>
<p>← END</p>	<p>We need a babysitter for our little girl. She likes to lay so make sure you're strong enough to O Y S [T] E R (hoist her) up.</p>	<p>Looking for a new member for our crew team.
